

Diss Crime Summary 4-10 September

South Norfolk Homewatch Message 12th September 2013

The past week has seen an increase in the theft from cars in the Wymondham area, specifically Roman Camp Caister St Edmund, Woodview Road, Easton, Three Mile Lane Costessey and Harts Lane Bawburgh. The property taken has included a brief case, camera, cash and number plates. Consider using the anti tamper proof screws for number plates and keep property out of view, preferably with you!

There have been three burglaries in the early hours of the morning which is very unusual for South Norfolk; two have been in Easton, Dereham Road and one in Hethersett. The offenders have gained entry in these burglaries by using an open window to gain access to a larger window and forcing a patio door. In Hethersett they were disturbed in the connecting garage. Cash and small items that are easy to carry are being targeted. Please look at your home security and put handbags, keys and wallets out of sight.

Unknown person(s) has smashed a light unit off the rear of the caravan and also forced open a front nearside window - causing no damage to the window. The intruders have then gone inside the caravan but have not stolen anything from within. No damage was caused inside either.

At 16.08hrs the same day an attempt was made to withdraw a £100.00 by using one of the stolen bank cards from the purse at the ATM at Tesco's, Victoria Road, Diss.

Once at the location, the male got out of the vehicle, stated 'wait a minute' then ran off without paying. He went into the village hall and failed to pay outstanding money.
