

**The following is a local policing update for the Diss neighbourhood  
Weekly crime summary 29 May-5 June 2014**

**Overview**

**After the house burglaries reported last week, this week there have been two attempts - one in Diss where the rear patio door was smashed and one in Tasburgh where the rear door window was broken to get access to the key which had been left in the lock on the inside. Thank fully on both occasions the offenders were disturbed and ran off empty handed. There has been a reduction in the number of sheds broken into this week with only one attempt in Easton where again nothing was stolen. Diss had three business units on Vinces Road broken into where petty cash and a mobile phone were stolen and unfortunately a charity shop, also in Diss, was broken into with 60 DVD's, a heart Pendant and a tray of 15 costume jewellery brooches were stolen along with a collection tin which contained cash.
