

Agreement between Blo' Norton Parish Council and Blo' Norton Village Hall Committee
with regard to Annual Donation

Extract from Minutes of the Blo' Norton Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 13 January 2015
at **7.30pm** in the Village Hall.

Village Hall Proposals All present were aware that the village hall committee struggle to improve facilities at the hall due to the running costs and maintenance. It was noted this was the only community facility that Blo' Norton had left. It was noted that currently the Parish Council paid a grant of £400 to the Village Hall for the meetings and grass cutting. The running costs of the hall were approximately £3250, money was raised through rental of the hall but this was never guaranteed. The Parish Council felt strongly that the village hall should be assisted and following discussion it was agreed to raise the precept by £2,600 so that the Parish Council would donate £3,000 per year to the Village Hall. The Parish Council hoped that this money would be sufficient to cover the cost of the routine running and maintenance of the hall and allow the monies raised by the Committee to be used for renovation and refurbishment.

A donation of £3,000 would be given from the Parish Council to the Village Hall within each financial year.

Payments of £1,000 would be made in May, September and February

Broken down the donation of £1,000 would comprise:

£140 rental and maintenance of Village Hall
£860 donation
