7. Update on previous matters.

- a. All Councillors agreed via email that they had no objection to the planning application 3PL/2017/1384 Brockmeadow Blo Norton, change of use from storage to residential. Comments to Breckland Council by the 5/2/18, Blo Norton Parish Council emailed no objection on the 3/2/18.
- b. Potholes etc, – N.C.C. have been spoken too on several occasions advising of pot holes, sandpits corner signpost, Hubbards Lane foot path (past village hall and council houses) N.C.C. concrete posts knocked down on the side of grass verge down towards Redgreave Road just before the concrete pad which usually has sugar beet on, new pot hole at Fen Road outside Fen Farm Barns, Hall Lane - trees coming down on top of each other, trees both side of the road going towards Hopton and Garboldisham Junction advised N.C.C. very dangerous a priority. There has been a notice put up on the two notice boards giving N.C.C. email and telephone no for people in the village to advise N.C.C. direct any pot holes, flooding etc as the more people than contact them the more likely they will do something about the issues.

8. Any Other Business

To discuss going forward Blo Norton Parish Council and Councillors and Clerk: To co-opt a member of the public to become a Parish Councillor and a Clerk, if at the meeting of the 6/2/18 a member of the parish was not co-opted on to the Council or Clerk then we may do so at this meeting.

There are three Councillors resigning, For two other Councillor members we need to give Breckland Notice on the 13/2/18 and a notice will be put up on the 15/2/18 for 14 days if no one comes forward and then the Parish Council will be able to co-opt two other Council Members on around the 7/3/18. Regarding a Clerk, Tjo has contacted Botesdale/Redgrave/Rickinghall, North Lopham, South Lopham, Hopton, East Harling to see if they would take on the position as well as their own Parish and they all declined, Garboldisham did not return the two calls made..
