Weekly crime summary 31 May-06 June 2013

Message from Chief Inspector Porter

I am pleased to report that crime in Breckland remained low over the past week and I am particularly happy to inform you that there were no house burglaries at all across the district.

However, there were a few incidents of outbuildings being broken into in the Swaffham area and grounds-keeping equipment including chainsaws, strimmers and hedge cutters were stolen.

With the above crimes in mind and the sun finally shining on us, I would ask you to consider the security of your sheds and outbuildings as many of you will be getting outside and tending to the garden. The following measures are advised:

- Ensure doors and windows on sheds and outbuildings are kept locked and secured at all times.
- Use close-shackle padlocks and bolt hasps and staples through the door and reinforce on the other side.
- Cover any windows so the contents inside cannot be seen.
- Consider securing expensive equipment internally either in a strong-box bolted to the floor or by chaining items together or to a ground anchor.
- Security mark equipment such as chainsaws and strimmers by painting or etching your postcode onto them.
- Enter serial numbers onto the national property database www.immobilsie.com
- Install a battery powered shed alarm.

You can dial 101 if you have any information about the crimes listed here or want to talk to local police about any issues.

The new non-emergency number is now in use across the country and is the quick and easy way to contact police in non-emergency situations. In an emergency, if a life is in danger or a crime is in progress, always use 999.

24306/13	Theft From A Motor Vehicle	ATTLEBOROUGH ROAD GREAT ELLINGHAM	Between 04 Jun 2013 17:15 and 05 Jun 2013 05:30	Offender gained entry by cutting wire fences which then gave access to three Renault lorries parked within. Varying amounts of diesel was then removed from the fuel tanks and exit point was as entry. Markings it field opposite would suggest the vehicle offenders used was hidden behind shrubbery away from road
